**MAY 2019**  
**BIRDS OF LORD HOWE ISLAND**

Showcasing Lord Howe Island's incredible bird species.

Witness thousands of Providence Petrel seabirds returning to their breeding grounds at dusk, as you assist in research into the movement patterns of our rare seabirds.



**JUNE 2019**  
**LORD HOWE ISLAND MARINE PARK**

Our seabirds and oceans are being impacted by plastic and marine debris.

Help survey the diverse intertidal ecosystem of Lord Howe Island Marine Park and provide valuable data for ongoing research. Undertake beach surveys to collect beach debris, sort and identify different plastic types as an aid to promoting solutions.



**JULY 2019**  
**INVASIVE SPECIES**

Invasive weeds are identified as one of the most serious threats to Lord Howe Island's biodiversity and World Heritage values.

Hike to remote and settlement locations and assist in weed removal with our experts, whilst learning about our world class Weed Eradication Program



**AUGUST 2019**  
**AMAZING INVERTEBRATES**

Rodents are voracious predators of invertebrates. The loss of invertebrates is particularly significant because invertebrates play an important role in maintaining natural ecological functions.

This month we will celebrate the discovery and revival of the rare Phasmid and the wider context of invertebrate conservation on Lord Howe Island and across the globe.



**SEPTEMBER 2019**  
**PROTECTING PARADISE**

September will highlight the very best of our island conservation above and below the water.

Lord Howe Island has a long history of sustainability and conservation programs ensuring the Island's unique biodiversity is safeguarded.
